# **Overview of Programs, Services, Staffing, & Support**

## **Budget Item: Cultural and Educational Programming**

#### **Black Grad Celebration**

The purpose of this event is to celebrate and recognize our Black scholars who graduated and moving onward in their lives. This celebration included books, stoles, DJ, and more. Finally, this event served as the first of its kind being a drive-thru celebration.

## Staff Salaries/Benefits

These funds were used to cover the salary and benefits of one professional staff member in the department. Also, these funds were used to pay for student staff salaries.

## **General Programming**

Throughout the academic year, African Student Programs hosted a variety of programs to engage and support Black scholars. This includes but is not limited to: Black Women's Appreciation, Self-Reverence program, Spirituality & Blackness, ASP Tap In/Merch Kits, among others..

## Student Org Support/Conferences

These funds were used to support student orgs' programming and needs. Programs such as the NSA Culture Show, Diversity Council, Journey Through Africa, BSU PATH Meet & Greet, and SGRHO Survival Guide among others were covered. Additionally, these funds were used to cover the travel of BSU to the ABCC and support a scholar who presented at a national conference.

## **Department Collaborations**

Monies went to support campus partners' programmatic initiatives and conferences that supported Black Scholars. These include programs such as Racial Justice Symposium, Black & UnDocumented.

#### **General Operating Expenses**

These funds were used to cover departmental purchases such as office supplies, equipment for programs, and other administrative needs.
