# **Budget Item: Staff Professional Development**

The WRC staff spent money on books for professional development, and the WRC Staff Book Club. Conferences were not an option, so this is much less than we normally spend.

# **Budget Item: Office Supplies/Tech**

This item refers to money spent on virtual platforms like MailChimp. Additionally, office supplies such as planners for staff and student staff were purchased.

### **Budget Item: Persist Conference**

The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Persist Women's Political Engagement Conference was held over Zoom in 2020, and had reduced costs as a result. We also had co-sponsorship money from the other UC Women's/Gender Centers.

# **Budget Item: RSAC Stipend**

We pay the RSAC student representative \$500 per quarter to serve on this committee.

# **Budget Item: VCSA Assessment Fee**

We used HESSR funds to pay for our VCSA assessment fee, which was \$2,419 last year.

## **Budget Item: Co-sponsorships**

We co-sponsored programs in the virtual setting, and also contributed \$5,000 to The WELL, who purchased menstrual cups to distribute during the pandemic.

## **Budget Item: Student Wages**

We spent over \$12,000 out of HESSR on student staff wages due to budget cuts in our other funds.
